THE CEREMONY of conferring degrees and awarding diplomas and certificates is a time-honoured ritual performed at academic institutions throughout the world. It is the moment when awards are formally made, and is a celebration of the achievements of the graduands.

Graduation ceremonies at the University of Divinity celebrate the academic excellence of our students, honour our collegiate structure and reveal the richness of the many Christian traditions which shape our identity.


The ceremony begins with the procession of the University's academic staff, doctoral graduands, distinguished guests, and members of the University's Council.

As befits a University of Divinity, the first part of the ceremony includes prayer, song, and a reading from scripture.

The formal graduation commences in the second part of the ceremony, when the Chair of the Academic Board certifies to the Chancellor that all graduands listed in the program, whether present or absent, have completed the requirements of their awards as established by the Council and the Academic Board.

Candidates for coursework awards are then presented to the Chancellor, grouped by Colleges, followed by candidates for research masters' degrees and doctoral awards.

The guest speaker delivers an address, and, following a final song and prayer, the ceremony concludes with the academic procession, now augmented by the new graduates.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

ALAN NIVEN came to Australia from England where he had trained as a languages teacher (French and Italian). Upon his arrival in Melbourne Alan studied with Churches of Christ, graduated with a Bachelor of Divinity from the Melbourne College of Divinity and was ordained. Following a period of ten years establishing a new church in Werribee, Alan was invited to lead a new parish community on the relocated Churches of Christ Theological College (now Stirling Theological College) Campus at Mulgrave, teaching part-time in practical ministry areas. He became the full-time lecturer in Pastoral and Family Studies, retiring from this role at the end of 2016.

Alan has taught continuously for thirty-six years alongside numerous pastoral ministries and responsibilities. His teaching covered: pastoral formation; pastoral care and counselling; marriage and family studies; grief and loss; violence and abuse; sustainable and safe ministry practice; and supervision. His research interests include: pastoral care and chaplaincy; and healthy practice and supervision. Alan is currently the Director of Research and Professional Development for Stirling Theological College. In November 2016 Alan Niven was the inaugural recipient of the University's Distinguished Service Medal.

This thesis evaluates Catherine LaCugna's theology in response to the criticism that she strays towards pantheism. Through critical engagement with pre-modern and contemporary theologians and by applying Kathryn Tanner's rule for talk about God as radically transcendent, it is argued that LaCugna's practical approach to trinitarian doctrine is informed by an account of divine transcendence.

Thesis: Jesus in Nigerian Christianity: An exploration of some aspects of Christology that may contribute to peace and mutuality

This thesis develops a contextual Christology for contemporary Nigeria against the backdrop of the lingering pressures on peace and mutuality, and influential “solution-oriented Christologies. It argues that Christological paradigms may provide a Christian alternative for social transformation when developed through the proclamation of the reign of the reconciling God.

Thesis: Contextualising Theology in the South Pacific With Lessons Learned from The “Gospel and Culture in Vanuatu” Project

Supervisor: The Reverend Dr Lawrence Nemer

This thesis establishes that the contextualisation of theology in the South Pacific must take account of key factors which profoundly shape its content and methodology. These factors are that South Pacific cultures are oral-based; and that they are defined by Melanesian and not Enlightenment categories. It is argued that the ‘Gospel and Culture in Vanuatu’ project offers a genuine theological model.

Zoran Vargovic

Stirling Theological College

Thesis: Exploring Narrative therapy practices within a Christian pastoral and theological context: Identifying a model of training, education and formation for Christian pastoral carers and counsellors

Supervisor: The Reverend Dr Alan Niven

This thesis integrates narrative principles with Christian pastoral care and counselling practices to create a ‘space educational model’ in which both teachers and students co-construct the curriculum. This empowers subjects’ voices, invites considerate use of language, suggests working with identities rather than selves, favours community rather than the individual, and applies multi-dimensional views of human experiences.

Thesis: Towards a Christology of Presence

This thesis develops a Christology organised around the concept of presence. The use of a holographic analogy highlights the importance of pneumatology in Christology and emphasises the indivisible nature of the continuing presence of the risen Christ in the Church and her liturgy.


