FEES AND FEE-HELP

FEE-HELP is the name of the Commonwealth Government education loan scheme. A FEE-HELP loan can cover all of a student's tuition fee. Students who are Australian citizens or holders of a permanent humanitarian visa are eligible for FEE-HELP.

To apply for FEE-HELP simply select this payment option on application, There is no upfront cost to eligible students.

COUNSELLING

Stirling offers the **Master of Counselling** in partnership with the Australian Institute of Family Counselling (AIFC).

The Master of Counselling offers advanced professional knowledge and skills for counsellors. This award has a strong focus on the student's personal attributes, relational capacity and spiritual formation as well as integrative and collaborative approaches to counselling.



SUPERVISION

Complete a postgraduate course in supervision, designed for experienced practitioners wishing to supervise others.

Stirling's supervision courses will form students as supervisors of ministry practice and develop key skills in supervision. Training is offered for supervisors in congregational, healthcare and community settings,

CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION (CPE)

Placement in a hospital (clinical) setting offers the opportunity to develop skills in pastoral and spiritual care with people across the spectrum of society and to integrate one's operational theology with the actual offering of care in situations of major and minor life transitions.

Level 1 and Level 2 are offered in partnership with ASACPEV (the Association for Supervised and Clinical Pastoral Education in Victoria, Inc).

Successful completion of one CPE placement receives two units of credit towards an award.



A one-year university course for young adults and emerging leaders.

Catalyst provides students with a unique learning experience to discover a wider worldview, discern calling and develop gifts and theological understanding. Catalyst has a core commitment to integrative mission and holistic gospel in vocation, justice, leadership and social entrepreneurship.

In one year, students complete two cross cultural immersion trips (overseas and local), learn from industry leaders who are making a difference in the world AND complete a university course!
