Summary of key activities

- B. The University Leadership Retreat, scheduled for 5 June, was postponed due to COVID lockdowns in Victoria. It has been rescheduled for Saturday 31 July 2021.
- C. The Service of Thanksgiving approved by Council for 31 August 2021 at St Paschal's Church will be held for 2020 graduates who were unable to graduate in person due to COVID restrictions on gatherings. It will also include a Graduation Ceremony for current HDR students who are approved eligible to graduate.
