THE CEREMONY of conferring degrees and awarding diplomas and certificates is a time-honoured ritual performed at academic institutions throughout the world. It is the moment when awards are formally made, and is a celebration of the achievements of the graduands.

Graduation ceremonies at the University of Divinity celebrate the academic excellence of our students, honour our collegiate structure and reveal the richness of the many Christian traditions which shape our identity.

The ceremony begins with the procession of the University's academic staff, doctoral graduands, distinguished guests, and members of the University's Council.

As befits a University of Divinity, the first part of the ceremony includes prayer and a reading from scripture.

The formal graduation commences in the second part of the ceremony, when the Chair of the Academic Board certifies to the Chancellor that all graduands listed in the program, whether present or absent, have completed the requirements of their awards as established by the Council and the Academic Board.

Candidates for coursework awards are then presented to the Chancellor, grouped by Colleges, followed by candidates for research masters' degrees and doctoral awards.

The guest speaker delivers an address and, following a final prayer, the ceremony concludes with the academic procession, now augmented by the new graduates.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

PROFESSOR KATHARINE MASSAM is an historian working at the intersection of theology and the lived experience of religion. Her work draws on oral histories, artefacts and fragmented sources, influenced especially by postcolonial and feminist analysis. Katharine teaches in the areas of history and spirituality. Her subjects include methodological surveys in both history and spirituality, and upper-level units focussed on developing a community of research practice.

Originally from Perth, Katharine moved to Melbourne to take up a position in Church History in 2000, and has remained part of the ecumenical faculty at what is now Pilgrim Theological College ever since. She has previously held positions at the University of Adelaide and Australian National University. Katharine's first book *Sacred Threads: Catholic Spirituality in Australia* (University of New South Wales Press, 1996) is a standard reference in the field. Her most recent book *A Bridge Between: Spanish Benedictine Missionary Women in Australia* (Australian National University Press, 2020) was shortlisted for the NSW Premier's National Prize in Australian History in 2021. It flows from a long-standing research collaboration with Aboriginal and Benedictine communities at New Norcia in Western Australia. That collaboration supported her election as a member of the Australian Institute of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Studies (AIATIS) in 2017.

Katharine is the Research Co-ordinator at Pilgrim where she has also served previously as Academic Dean (June-December 2016 and again from January 2018 to January 2021). She is secretary of the Religious History Association, a board member of the Australian Cardijn Institute and a founding member and current convenor of the Australian Collaborators in Feminist Theologies.

Katharine was appointed a Professor of the University of Divinity in November 2021, noted for her outstanding contribution to Learning and Teaching, Research, and Leadership in the Academy.

The thesis is an analysis of three early Syriac martyrologies (calendars of saints) utilizing various sociological theories of memory and time presented as three diachronic case studies: 1. martyrologies as sites of memory; 2. role of reputational entrepreneurs and reputational trajectories in martyr commemorations; 3. commemorating earthquakes.

University Medal 2022

Citation: Dr Katherin Papadopoulos has completed a doctoral dissertation of exceptional quality which offers thought-provoking insights in its application of memory studies to the literature of late antique history, literature, and culture. Her thesis, Patterning the Past: Memory Studies and Late Antique Syriac Martyrologies, applies various sociological theories of memory to the practices of remembering the past as presented by Syriac martyrologies (calendars of saints) in order to uncover the values and master narratives about the past which were important to the groups that compiled the calendars, how they changed, and the socio-cultural currents that may have shaped them. Dr Papadopoulos's thesis is praised for its deep, sustained, and incisive scholarship and for its high level of philological engagement.



Joel Maurice Rothman

Whitley College

Thesis: Cosmology and the Cosmic Journey in the Book of Revelation: The Experience of Story-Space and Conflicting Visions of Reality
Supervisors: Associate Professor Keith Dyer and Reverend Dr Robyn Whitaker

Revelation draws the hearer into its story-space, a four-layered cosmos of hyper-heaven, sky-heaven, earth, and abyssal depths. The spatial construction has ideological import: in the conflicted sky-heaven empire is exposed as draconian, thus demanding nonparticipation in its social and economic practices, while the transformative hyper-heaven makes nonparticipation a genuine option.

University Medal 2022

Citation: Dr Joel Maurice Rothman has completed a doctoral thesis of exceptional quality which offers an innovative reading of the Book of Revelation. His thesis, Cosmology and the Cosmic Journey in the Book of Revelation: The Experience of Story-Space and Conflicting Visions of Reality, provides a novel interpretation of the relationship of cosmic spaces in Revelation. Using narrative criticism, Rothman proposes a four-tiered structure of the cosmos which offers a unique perspective on the purpose of the Apocalyptic book.

Thesis: Martin Luther's 'Common Priesthood' Its Boundaries and Horizons: A Study in Luther's Ecclesiology
Supervisors: Professor Wendy Mayer, Dr Jeff Silcock and Dr Stefan Gigacz

The thesis demonstrates that Luther's teaching on the common priesthood was a persistent and pervasive element of his ecclesiology, the church as the communion of saints. Its focus is on the common priesthood in the Christian community, beyond its contentious relationship to the church's ordained ministry.

University Medal 2022

Citation: Dr Roger William Whittall has completed a doctoral thesis of exceptional quality which provides a comprehensive study of Luther's teaching on the common priesthood. His thesis, Martin Luther's 'Common Priesthood' Its Boundaries and Horizons: A Study in Luther's Ecclesiology, comprehensively traces the concept of the priesthood of all believers through a range of Luther's writings, contributing to contemporary debate on the relationship of the priesthood for the baptised and the calling to public ministry. Dr Whittall demonstrates thoroughness in his examination of primary sources, writing with clarity and grace.

The star is a biblical symbol that appears in the heavens to point wise ones on earth towards the Christ. It is also an Australian symbol, as shown by the federal star and the Southern Cross on the Australian flag.

The books which make up the star represent wisdom, and are open to critical interpretation. The gathering of these many parts into a whole expresses the collegiate shape of the University.

The gold represents excellence. The distinctive accent is red, representing passion and sacrifice which facilitate and flow from the study of divinity.

The constellation of books creates two stars, one on the outside and one on the inside, illustrating the University's commitment to tradition and innovation. Through critical study, the University brings ancient truths into dialogue with the issues of the contemporary world.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The University Mace was commissioned in 2017 from F. J. Rocca Silversmiths in Carlton, Victoria. The Mace is based on the University Badge, which appears at the tip of the Mace on a head of brass.
