DECLARATION OF RESULT Academic Board Student Members Election Hannah Hornsby, University Secretary 19 November 2024



On Friday 20 September 2024, the Academic Board authorised a call for nominations to fill membership vacancies for a Coursework student and a Higher Degree by Research student. The nomination and election process was conducted in accordance with the University's Election and Nomination Policy.

The call for nominations closed at 5pm on Monday 11 November.

One nomination was received in the category of Higher Degree by Research student, from Sarah Callista of Pilgrim College. As only one person was nominated, no election was required, and according to section 8.7 of the Elections and Nominations Policy, the University Secretary declared Sarah Callista duly elected.

Two nominations were received in the category of coursework student:

- 1. Hamish McLachlan (St Barnabas College)
- 2. Mamta Prasad (School of Professional Practice)

An election was held, with the election portal open for voting from Tuesday 12 November to 5pm (AEDT) Monday 18 November. 187 votes were cast, and Hamish McLachlan was elected with 52% of the vote.

The results are declared as follows:

- 1. Hamish McLachlan was elected as Coursework student member of the Academic Board for a term of two years, from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2026.
- 2. Sarah Callista was elected as the Higher Degree by Research student member of the Academic Board for a term of two years, from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2026.
